Junior Research Fellow

The NATO Association of Canada, founded in 1966, informs Canadians about the importance of NATO's goal of peace and security in an increasingly interconnected world. By exploring Canada's role in global affairs and highlighting the experience of international collaboration, the NATO Association promotes awareness and appreciation for peace, prosperity and security in Canada. The Association hosts both small and large events featuring members of the diplomatic corps, the military, business community, politicians and academia. The Association also has outreach programs and publishes articles every week to engage Canadians in international affairs.

The Junior Research Fellowship is a research and writing position and involves writing one article each week over a 4-month period on a designated topic of interest. It is ideal for candidates with an aptitude for research who wish to publish articles on subject of interest. The successful applicant will have sufficient writing experience and enthusiasm and will require excellent communication and research skills. The Junior Research Fellow will work with and report to a Program Editor responsible for the program they've been assigned to. The Junior Research Fellow is responsible for publishing weekly articles on the topic that correlates to their assigned program. They may pitch articles to Program Editors of other programs within the NATO Association, which will be reviewed on an ad-hoc basis.

In addition, if they wish, the Junior Research Fellow will have the option of assisting their Program Editor on various NATO Association projects. Work on projects may be done in lieu of submissions of articles on some weeks throughout the duration of the contract. However, the Junior Research Fellowship remains primarily a research and writing-heavy position.

Ideal Candidate Education and Experience:

Bachelor's Degree (completed or ongoing) in International Affairs, Politics, History, English, Journalism, Media, or related fields. Bilingualism in English and French is an asset.
